

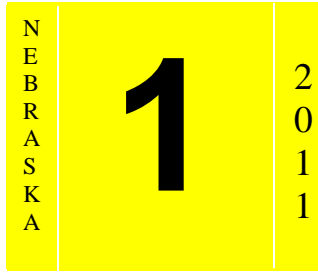

 <p>NEBRASKA FILM VEHICLE 1234 2011</p>	<p>Film Vehicle (State Issued)</p> <p>2 Plates 1 Plate (Trailers)</p>	<p>Issued to non-resident film production companies temporarily on location in Nebraska. With approval from the Department of Economic Development, application is made to the Department of Motor Vehicles. §60-327</p>

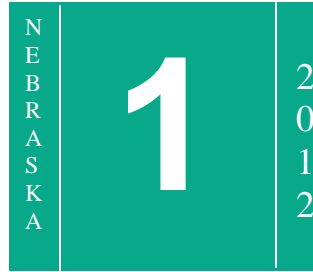

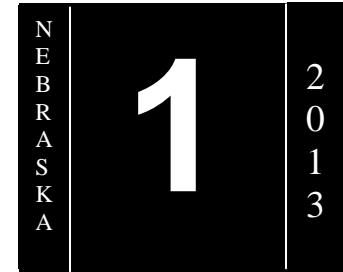

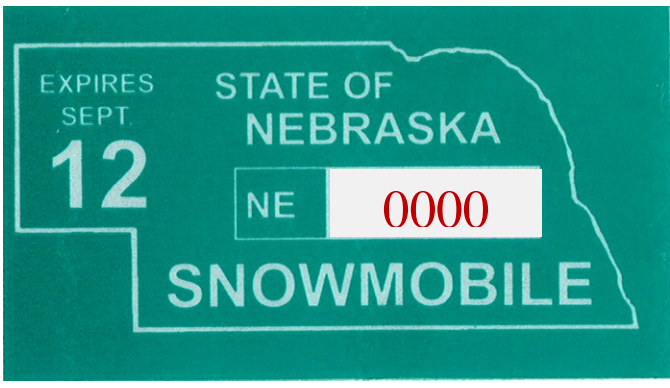

Affixed to Vintage [vehicle](#) and [motorcycle](#) license plates to indicate plate has been approved by the Department and that the plate is valid.



[Permanent Handicapped
Parking Permit](#)

Issued at no fee to handicapped individuals who have been medically certified with a permanent condition.

Two permits allowed per handicapped individual. Permit is assigned to the individual and can be used in any vehicle when the holder is entering and/or exiting the vehicle.

Permits expire on the individual's birth date, 3 years after issuance.

[Temporary Handicapped
Parking Permit](#)

Issued at no fee to handicapped individuals who have been medically certified with a disability expected to last no more than 6 months. May be renewed once for an additional 6 month period. One permit allowed per individual.

Two permits allowed per handicapped individual. Permit is assigned to the individual and can be used in any vehicle when the holder is entering and/or exiting the vehicle.

Permits expire 6 months after the date of issuance.
